

The JCC Mid Westchester is seeking a **Parent Ambassador** to serve as a resource and guide for the hundreds of families moving to lower/mid Westchester looking to connect with their new, Jewish community. The person in this recently created position will develop welcoming programs for families, including entry/low barrier Jewish experiences, one on one parent conversations, small scale family gatherings – utilizing in virtual, in-person, and hybrid models.

The Parent Ambassador will be mentored and supported by JCCMW staff, specifically in the early childhood education programs. The primary audience for the Parent Ambassador is families with children age 0-5.

Ideally, a Parent Ambassador will live in and be a part of our mid/lower Westchester community and be familiar with some of our existing community resources. Additionally, this person will be:

- Excited to meet, welcome, and get to know parents raising Jewish children
- An excellent communicator and listener, and someone who excels at relationship building
- Passionate about Jewish life, and excited to infuse Jewish themes into programs
- Understanding and respectful of the range of Jewish connection and knowledge among parents and families
- Interested in facilitating and participating in new opportunities for peers to meet each other
- Familiar with online communication outlets for parents in their community
- Demonstrated ability to work independently, as well as part of a team
- Demonstrated knowledgeable of the local community's parent resources, both within and outside of the Jewish community
- Approximately 20-25 hours/month. Connectors can make up to \$10,000 for the year and is a great opportunity for someone interested in a part time role in their community.
