Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

We are looking for a Competitive Gymnastics Coordinator/Head Coach to join our team. The successful candidate will report to the Director of Gymnastics and provide instruction to children of all ages in the Gymnastics Department. This will include teaching 1-4 hour sessions, sharing the vision of our USAG competitive curriculums, and competitions, creating lesson plans and evaluating gymnasts. Additionally, the incumbent will be leading the competitive team staff during practice.

This is a full-time role (up to 40 hours per week). The successful candidate will be available to work 4-6 days per week including some weekends.

- Work with children of all ages, primarily ages 5-14
- Use positive and constructive communication with kids and parents
- Creatively incorporate curriculum into the lesson plans and submit evaluations per session
