



Competitive Gymnastics Coach

Job description:

The successful candidate will report to the Director of Gymnastics and provide instruction within the Gymnastics Department. This will include sharing the vision for our USAG competitive curriculums and competitions, learning and teaching routines, constructing lesson plans per level and group, following Director's lead for all practices, evaluating gymnasts throughout the year.

This is a part-time role (up to 30 hours per week). The successful candidate will be available to work 2-6 days per week including weekends for practice and competition.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teach 1-3 hour sessions
- Coach USAG Development Program and Xcel Program Levels
- Work with children of all ages, primarily ages 5-16
- Use positive and constructive communication
- Creatively incorporate curriculum into the lesson plans and submit evaluations per session
- Actively engage during activities or events with gymnasts
- Work collaboratively with other instructors to maintain order and participation during sessions
- Attend monthly meetings and development trainings
- Attend sanctioned competitive events on weekends
- Encourage a positive environment promoting mutual support and the desire to learn and grow
